# CRAA Swimming Rates & Registration Information

All swimmers must be registered with CRAA in order to start swimming with CRAA. When registering, families are agreeing to enter a contract with CRAA. In this contract, CRAA, Inc. will provide pool time along with a qualified coaching staff that will give instruction in competitive swim techniques at practices and approved swim meets. For these services, the recipient will compensate CRAA based on the following:

- **CRAA Swimming Dues**
- **CRAA Fair Share**
- **CRAA Work Sessions**
- **CRAA Additional Commitments**

Prior to starting the Fall/Winter Season and/or the Spring Summer Season, all swimmers must be USA Swimming members and complete CRAA team registration through the CRAA web site. To complete the registration process, swimmers will need to pay season's registration fee at check-out by electronic check or credit/debit card.

In addition to each swimmer's registration fee, swimmers are also responsible for monthly dues. Swimmers will receive statements from the CRAA office at the end of each month. Payments of the monthly statements must be paid directly to the CRAA office by cash or check.

Swimmers may elect to conclude their seasonal participation by contacting the CRAA office in writing by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month prior to the conclusion of their participation. For example, a swimmer who wishes to conclude their participation in December must contact the CRAA office in writing by November 15<sup>th</sup>. Swimmers choosing to resume their participation within a season may rejoin the team without paying a registration fee a second time.

Swimmers choosing to start after the season has begun are responsible for the team registration fee and only the monthly dues for which they participate.
