Timed Final for 11-12, 9-10, and 8/Under. Prelim-Final for 13-14 and 15/Older.

LOCATION: University of Minnesota Aquatic Center, 1910 University Ave. SE, Minneapolis, MN. Telephone for emergency use only: (612) 626-1352.

Please note that two major construction projects are underway at and near the Aquatic Center. Some streets south of the Aquatic Center have been closed or restricted. Both entrances on the south side of the University Aquatic Center will be closed. The only access point is on the north side of the Aquatic Center.

FACILITY: Two 8 - lane, 25-yard indoor competition courses with lane lines and backstroke pennants. Slanted starting blocks 26" above water surface; pool depths at the starting ends are 7' to 7'10". Separate 25-yard warm-up facilities in the diving pool may be provided on a space-available basis.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Both competition courses will be utilized for all sessions except the Saturday and Sunday night finals.

MEET INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS: All information, rules and regulations, including time standards, schedules, orders of events and meet operations will be in accordance with Minnesota Swimming and USA Swimming rules and regulations.

AGE GROUP MEET: Age of swimmer determined by their age as of January 13, 2012 (first day of the meet).

USA SWIMMING OR FINA MEMBERSHIP: All swimmers MUST BE athlete members of USA Swimming or other FINA-member organization. All coaches allowed access on deck MUST be coach members of USA Swimming or FINA-member organization. The representative submitting entries shall be responsible for verifying that all swimmers and coaches satisfy these requirements. Any club or individual entering a swimmer who is not an athlete member of USA Swimming or FINA will be subject to a \$25.00 fine per event per swimmer. Coaches will be asked to display credentials upon check-in and during all sessions of the meet.

OVERSIZED MEET: If the meet becomes oversized the host club will implement Minnesota Swimming and USA Swimming procedures to reduce the size of the meet as required and notify all participating teams accordingly.

Four-Hour Rule for Age Group Sessions: The USA Swimming four-hour rule will be followed. If the meet becomes too large, MSI 4-Hour Rule Policy (#244) will be followed.

TIME STANDARDS/QUALIFICATION: 2009-2012 Minnesota Swimming Time Standards will be utilized. Minimum qualification of "A" is required for individual events.

Age groups of 8/Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15/Older will be utilized.

15/Older males will utilize the SAME standard as 13-14 males. 15/Older female standards are derived from 15-16 females. 11-12 400 IM standards are adapted from the 2009-2012 National Age Group Motivational Times.

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to participate in this meet. Disabled competitors may enter all events corresponding to their age and gender. There is no qualifying standard for disabled swimmers. When submitting entries please attach a note if a competitor is entering as a disabled swimmer.

SEED TIMES/ENTRIES: All entry times must be in either short course yards (seeded first) or long course meters (seeded next). Short course meters times may be converted and entered as short course yards times.

Relays do not count against individual event limits.

WARM-UP & WATER ENTRY: Minnesota Swimming and USA Swimming rules govern all aspects of warm-up and competition. Swimmers and coaches are expected to be acquainted with all rules and obligations. Failure to follow these rules will result in disqualification of swimmer(s) or coach(es) from next individual event or expulsion from the meet.

During warm-ups the Minnesota Slip-In Entry and No Diving rules will be in effect in all pools (except for designated sprint lanes) and will be strictly enforced. No horseplay will be permitted.

The host club reserves the right to utilize split warm-up procedures according to Minnesota Swimming rules. If split warm-ups become necessary, all participating teams will be notified in advance of each session.

ENTRIES: Entries must be completed by a club or individual who will be solely responsible for the accuracy of the entry. E-mail entries are preferred. Please call the Entry Chairperson for directions if you need to hand-deliver.

Minnesota teams must use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible software to run swim meets. Those teams using disk entry must use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible software to enter this meet. There will be no disks sent out to clubs. Please include a printed and proofed copy of your COMMLINK REPORT, along with your disk, Code of Conduct, Fee Calculation Form and payment of fees (one consolidated check per club). Minnesota clubs entering this meet must use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible disk entry unless your club is on record and approved by MSI that you cannot comply with the disk entry requirement. Clubs outside of the state of Minnesota may use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible to enter this meet or may use the entry form included with this entry. All Swimmers must be members of USA Swimming and entered in the meet with their proper name and 14-digit USA Swimming identification number.

EMAIL ENTRIES: All teams are encouraged to utilize email. Email entries to foxjetwinterclassic@gmail.com. Attach to the email your Commlink Report and Fee Calculation Form. **If you do not receive an e-mail confirmation within 24 hours, your entries were not received.**

Please note that emailed entries are in addition to, and do not replace, the normal entry procedure as stated above, which includes Commlink hard copy report, fee calculation form, Code of Conduct and payment, which are due upon arrival/check-in at the meet. No teams or athletes will be permitted to participate until all forms and payment are received. This makes check-in at the meet very important! All coaches/teams must check-in to ensure proper entry.

ENTRIES DUE: 6:00 PM CT, Wednesday, January 4, 2012

LATE QUALIFICATION: Swimmers/teams qualifying for this meet after the entry deadline must submit their entries prior to 2:00 PM CT on Monday, January 9. These entries may be emailed, hand-delivered or telephoned to the Meet Entry Chairperson. No entries will be accepted after the deadline. Only additions to the original entry will be accepted. Deletions to existing entries will not be accepted.

FEES: \$2.50 MSI Fee per swimmer (including "relay only" swimmers), \$5.00 per individual splash, \$20.00 per relay. Summarize costs with fee calculation form. Checks must accompany entries and made payable to: **TEAM FOXJET**

MEET CHECK IN: Meet check-in will take place all day on Friday. A coaches table will be positioned near the scorers table. The Entry Chair will accept all required entry information and advise coaches on the use of the Coaches Box that will be used to pass on relevant information during the meet. Coaches not attending Friday Evening Sessions should contact Entry Chair upon their arrival at the pool.

OPEN LANE SWIMS: The Minnesota Swimming Open Lane Swim procedure will be utilized. The splash fee is \$5.00. Sign-up is on a space-available basis with the Entry Chair. Swimmers must already be registered in the meet in order to participate in Open Lane swims. Swimmers may not exceed their daily event limit, including Open Lane swims. Swimmers may scratch an event in order to swim an Open Lane swim (to stay within the entry limit), but no refunds will be given for scratched events.

MEET FORMAT:

Check-in with the Entry Chair is required by 5:00 PM on Friday.

Friday Evening – all events are Timed Final, **POSITIVE CHECK-IN, DECK SEEDED**, run fastest to slowest. The 13-14 and 15/Over events will be combined heats; placed and scored by age group. Both competition courses will be utilized. Friday evening events’ psych sheets will be posted on the Team Foxjet website (www.teamfoxjet.com) by Wednesday, January 11th for an advanced look at these events.

Saturday and Sunday Morning – Prelims for 13-14 and 15/Older, both competition courses will be utilized. Finalist will race in separate 13-14 and 15/Over heats during finals. There will be a break after the relays to provide adequate recovery time.

Preliminary events will advance the following number of swimmers to the finals.

In those events with only the top 8 advancing places 9 through 16 will be scored from preliminaries. The Minnesota Swimming Scratch Rule will be in effect.

The 13/Older 500 Free is a Timed Final, **POSITIVE CHECK-IN** and **DECK SEEDED**, with the fastest eight seeded directly (top eight 13-14 & 15/Over) into Finals. The Minnesota Swimming Scratch Rule will be in effect.

Saturday and Sunday Afternoon – Timed Finals for 8/Under, 9-10, and 11-12. Both competition courses will be utilized. There will be a break after the relays to provide adequate recovery time.

Saturday and Sunday Evening – Finals for 13-14 and 15/Older. The East competition course will be utilized.

When both competition courses are used concurrently, events are distributed between the two courses in a manner which preserves the order of events for each age group.

RELAYS: All teams entered in the meet are permitted at least one relay entry per relay event, regardless of swimmers’ times, provided that all relay teams meet the following criteria:

1. All swimmers must be attached, registered members of their team. No unattached swimmers may participate.
2. All swimmers must be entered in an individual event, or entered as a “Relay Only” or “Relay Alternate” swimmer.
3. Teams may enter more than one relay in a relay event only if the number of swimmers they have participating in individual events in that age group exceeds the number of swimmers in increments of four needed to field a relay (4 or less swimmers = 1 relay, 5 swimmers = 2 relays, 9 swimmers = 3 relays, and so forth).

Teams that submit relays entries with names will have those names appear on their relay card(s) when those cards are distributed at the meet. Teams are encouraged to utilize this method, which can hasten relay card submission on deck.

ALL RELAYS ARE TIMED FINAL. ALL HEATS OF 13/OVER RELAYS WILL BE SWUM DURING THE MORNING PRELIMINARIES.

CLERK OF COURSE: All swimmers report directly to their blocks.

SCORING: All events scored to sixteen places. Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Relay events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2.

AWARDS: All swimmers compete within their age group and gender for score/awards. Individual events 1st-8th place medals, relays 1st-3rd place medals. Individual High Point Awards (Top 3) for swimmers in each age group and gender. Team Plaques will be awarded for 1st-3rd place teams in each Division (AAA, AA, A). Non-Minnesota clubs will be placed in the AAA Division. The host team is ineligible for team awards. Awards will be given out to athletes 30 minutes after posting of the final results.

Racing start certification: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Swimmers Without a Coach Present: USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.

TIMELINES: Any timeline provided, website or meet program, is for informational purposes only and subject to change as the meet progresses. Session start times are only approximations, be aware that sessions may start earlier than published.

COACHES' MEETINGS: Will take place on at the discretion of the Referee. Meetings will not take place during warm-up (or competition) unless a serious issue warrants immediate discussion.

CHANGES TO MEET INFORMATION: Any proposed changes to the meet information will be discussed at the coaches meeting(s), and require a 100% affirmative vote for approval by all teams represented at the meeting.

Meet Committee: A meet committee will be formed by the meet referee. It will consist of at least one official (excluding the meet referee), one coach (not from the host club) and one athlete (not from the host club). Judgment decisions cannot be protested.

FINAL RESULTS: Each team's final results will be emailed the following day, January 16th. If results are needed in a special format, contact the Entry Chair.

OFFICIALS: Team Foxjet welcomes all officials from participating clubs. Anyone who is certified as an official, wanting to fulfill on-deck training, or just wishes to participate for love of the sport, should make their availability known in advance to the Meet Director or Meet Referee.

This meet will be submitted for designation as an "Officials Qualifying Meet" for certification and re-certification evaluations. Applications for evaluation, found on the Minnesota Swimming web site, may be e-mailed to the Meet Referee. Not all applications for evaluation may be accepted. Opportunities for evaluations may be restricted by the available officiating positions, number of evaluators, and positions which the evaluators may evaluate.

CONCESSIONS, MEMORABILIA, PROGRAMS, EQUIPMENT: Will be on sale during each session.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: No spectators are permitted on the pool deck or in adjacent competition-related spaces. No street shoes are allowed on the pool deck. Coaches, swimmers, officials and volunteers are requested to wear tennis shoes. No glass or other breakables are permitted anywhere in the Aquatic Center.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
