Registration Update

The CRAA registration link has now been posted on the CRAA website at www.craa.org. *All swimmers currently practicing with CRAA need to register for the 2009 Spring and Summer season through this website.*

Note: This is the first time CRAA has used the Active Network's service for online swim team registration. Currently, individuals cannot make a payment through this website when registering. The site is designed to present all financial obligations when registering an individual for the upcoming summer swim season. A summary of financial obligations will be displayed at the end of the registration process. Monthly invoices will continue to be mailed to each family and payments will continue to be made through the CRAA business office.

We are aware that the site is not without a few small problems. For example, the groups have been set so that once a swimmer's age has been entered, only the practice group that meets that swimmer's age will be available for registration. The dates set are not 100% accurate. If this happens, please select the closest practice group to your swimmer's current practice group and continue through the registration process. At the end, please be aware that the financial summary will be incorrect. This summary will be adjusted and monthly statements will reflect these corrections.
